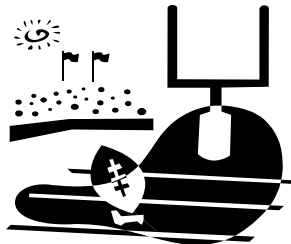

If participants leave the facility before the dance is over an attempt will be made to notify their parents and they will not be allowed back in. Give any special information (medical conditions) concerning your child to a CRC staff member. **Dances will follow SCHOOL DRESS CODE.** Participants found to be dressed inappropriately will be allowed to call their parents to bring a change of clothing or pick them up. If staff is unable to contact parents, participants will be required to sit out the dance. Maximum occupancy loads will be strictly enforced.



Student ID's must be presented to attend dances.

Cost to attend dance is \$4.00 includes first drink from concessions. Participants will pay for any additional drinks from the concession stand.

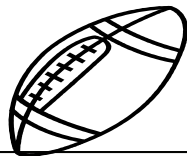

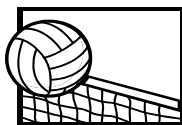

1. **REGISTRATION** for all 2008 Fall programs will be taken at the Chanute Recreation Commission , 1621 W. 14th, beginning Monday, August 18th.
2. **OFFICE HOURS** for the Recreation Commission are 8:30 am - 1:00 pm and 2:00 - 5:00 pm Monday - Friday. If you are unable to come to the Recreation Office during regular office hours, the appropriate registration form(s) can be mailed or faxed to you. Please call the CRC Office at 431-4199. Forms may also be downloaded at the City of Chanute website: www.chanute.org.
3. Sorry, **NO TELEPHONE REGISTRATIONS** accepted unless noted in brochure.
4. **PRE-REGISTRATION** is required for all programs. Registration is done on a first come, first serve basis. Waiting lists will be formed when classes are full.
5. **PLEASE KEEP A RECORD OF CLASSES IN WHICH YOU ENROLL.** You will not be notified about your class unless there is a change made or it is canceled.
6. **NO REFUNDS** will be given after a one time class, or after the second class meeting. Classes with insufficient numbers will be canceled and a refund given. CRC reserves the right to cancel or combine activities.
7. **POSTPONEMENT** of activities due to inclement weather will be announced on KKOY and KINZ and on our program information line (620) 431-0061.
8. There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks.
9. Scholarships are available to help cover program fees. Please contact the Recreation Office for additional information or an application.

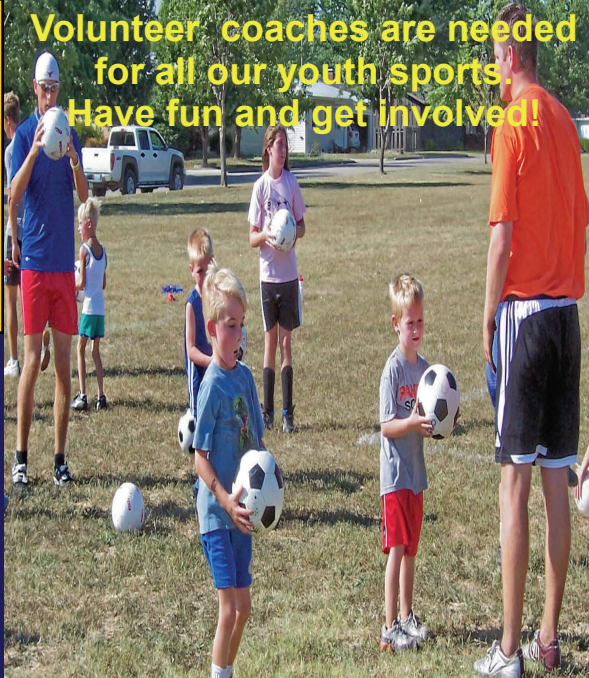


IMPORTANT REMINDERS
