### **DISTRIBUTION – GAS UTILITY**

#### **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

Performs various job tasks generally involving working with crew on distribution system. Works under the general supervision of the Gas Crew Foreman.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- Works with crew on installation and maintenance of natural gas distribution system.
- Uses jackhammers, pipe threaders, pipe cutters and various hand and power tools used in the construction and maintenance of gas facilities.
- Fuse polyethylene pipe and fittings.
- Operates pipe locating and leak detecting equipment.
- Drives crew trucks and dump trucks, operate backhoe, trencher, directional drill or other equipment when needed.
- Recognize and react to safety hazards associated with gas and other underground construction.
- Follow oral and written instructions and the ability to write legibly on forms & reports.
- Other duties as assigned.

#### **POSITION REQUIREMENTS**

- High School diploma or GED and willing to continue education.
- Knowledgeable in all phases of pipeline safety, job site safety, etc.
- Knowledgeable in computers and electronic equipment.
- Knowledge in operating various types of excavation equipment.
- Experience as a pipefitter.
- Possess or obtain a valid Commercial Class A Kansas driver's license.
- Reside within a ten (10) mile radius of the East City Complex located at 1002 East 14th.
- Pass Operator Qualification written test, skill and ability evaluations within 6 months.
- Maintain Operator Qualification requirements per D.O.T. Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.
- Attend out of town meeting when required for training, etc.
- Good employee/public relations skills.
- Good work attendance/performance record.
- Adverse weather and environment may be encountered, may be called out evenings, nights and weekends.
- Work overtime as needed.
- Random drug screen testing.
- May be required to answer trouble calls.
- Experience in pipefitting and Polyethylene Fusion.
- Maintain good attendance record.
- Start standby rotation within one year of employment for after-hours, which will include working weekends, holidays, and overtime as needed.
